- Create and monitor a Person-Centered Plan (PCP) reflective of their strengths, needs, dignity, personal goals, choices, and values.
- Coordinate services and supports; assist with problem solving as needed.

BILLABLE POSITION

This position requires daily entry of billable care coordination documentation: 30 billable units per day/150 units per week, excluding observed holidays and paid time off. Experience with a billing system for case management, such as LTSSMaryland, is a plus.

CASELOAD SIZE

At TCS, Coordinators of Community Services carry a caseload of 30 - 40 people ranging in age from children to older adults.
